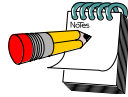

Elementary School Tuition Aid

Now is the time to turn in tuition assistance applications for the **2017-2018** school year. If you have not yet received your forms from the school, please call the school and inquire about them.

Regarding Catholic School Assistance:

The Diocese of Providence urges all parishes to support Catholic Schools by giving aid, as far as possible, when parents request it. As a believer in the value of Catholic Schools, we are happy to do that, both to the fullest extent allowable, and to the extent that the parish can afford. Some things to note, however! Eligibility for consideration requires that families:

1. **Complete the Facts Form from the Catholic School Office.**
2. **You must be registered parishioners of St. Francis of Assisi Parish & contributing members for at least a one year period.**
3. **Attend Mass regularly.**
4. **Be actively involved in St. Francis of Assisi parish life.**
5. **All requests are to be turned into the parish office, whether your child has been accepted or not, by April 30.**

Please submit your assistance request **either by mail** to St. Francis of Assisi, 114 High St., Wakefield, RI 02879 or **by email** to saintfrancis00@aol.com. You must state in this request how you are active in this parish.

Dr. Sandra Keating will present a discussion entitled *"What Every Christian Should Know About Islam"* on **Monday, March 20 at 7:00pm in Fr. Greenan Center**. Dr. Keating, a professor at Providence College, received her Ph.D. at Catholic University of America & teaches & publishes in the area of comparative religion with an emphasis on Catholic-Muslim Relations, particularly theological exchange in the early medieval period. Dr. Keating is a member of the USCCB Catholic-Muslim dialogue group and has served as a Consultor of the Vatican Commission for Religious Relations with Muslims.
