

From the Pastor

Good news. The bishop has agreed to assign Deacon Patrick Moynihan to our parish. He is committed to working for the Haitian Project for the next few years but will be able to diaconate here and help me with pastoral work, preaching, teaching, weddings, wakes and burials whenever he's in Rhode Island, which will be the bulk of the time.

Christina Moynihan has jumped right into her work as pastoral assistant and has visited the various residences of our older parishioners and led the residents at Indian Run for what she calls an Empowerment Session. We are working on systematizing our parish communion call list and will be sitting down with those who bring communion to the shut-ins to make sure everyone is being seen on a more regular basis and that everyone also gets to see the priest at least once or twice a year. In this regard, we'd really like you to let us know if any of your family members, friends or neighbors who are parishioners of our parish are no longer able to get to Mass. We cannot keep track of everyone and depend on you to let us know when you're in need.

Christina is also planning to gather the heads of the various ministries so that they can get to know one another and her, which is not only useful but a fun thing to do from time to time.

Also: please pray for our children who will be receiving First Holy Communion this coming Saturday at 10 a.m. and for their families. The children will also be invited to participate in the May crowning of the statue of the Blessed Mother immediately following the 10 o'clock Mass next Sunday. A welcome reception for Patrick and Christina Moynihan will follow the crowning. Come all ye!

The ongoing saga of the parking lot: work is now scheduled to begin on May 9, a week from this Monday, and should be done before the following weekend.


