Statement of Peace

We will only pursue peaceful solutions to the violence of abortion...we will show compassion and reflect Christ’s love to all (abortion facility) employees, volunteers and clients...we understand that acting in a violent or harmful manner immediately and completely disassociates anyone from the 40 Days for Life campaign...we will not obstruct driveways or sidewalks while standing in the public right of way...we will not litter...we will closely attend to any children we bring to the prayer vigil...we will not threaten, physically contact, or verbally abuse abortion facility workers/volunteers/customers...we will not vandalize private property and we will cooperate with local city authorities!
