

PARISH LENTEN MISSION: "THE FACE OF GOD IN MERCY:
REFLECTIONS ON THE PRODIGAL SON"
BEGINS THE WEEKEND OF APRIL 6<sup>TH</sup> & 7<sup>TH</sup>

Saturday-Sunday, April 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>—Fr. Nathan Ricci will preach at all weekend liturgies at St. Francis Church. He will present our 2019 Lenten Mission titled, "The Face of God in Mercy: Reflections on the Prodigal Son": Pope Francis recently reflected that the "face of God is mercy." What did the Holy Father mean by this? By reflecting upon the Prodigal Son with Scripture and Tradition, Saint Pope John Paul II and others, we will delve deeper into the richness of God's mercy.

- Monday, April 8<sup>th</sup>—7pm: Tonight we will focus on the younger son, who had everything, but squandered it all. Why did he leave, and what made him return? We will reflect on the nature of sin, habits of vice, and the divine whisper calling us home. (Confessions heard 6-6:45pm)
- Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>—7pm: Tonight's focus will be on the older son, who was seemingly forgotten and who objects to the elemency bestowed upon his brother. How do we respond to sinners in our midst? Is mercy fair? Tonight we reflect upon the relationship between mercy and justice. (Confessions heard 6-6:45pm)
- Wednesday, April 10<sup>th</sup>—7pm: Tonight's focus will be on the father who welcomes home his son. Why does the father show clemency on the son who has abandoned him? What insights can we gain from this parable about the mercy of God? Tonight we reflect on the divine Essence, which is Love, as well as the attribute of God's mercy, and the relationship between the two. (Confessions heard 6-6:45)
