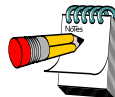

From the Pastor,

A couple of weeks ago, we completed the Alpha course. Twenty parishioners from here and from Ascension Episcopal parish, plus a couple of people who belonged to no particular parish, came here each week for fellowship, food, and a refresher course on basic Christian life. Each Thursday evening 's session began with an excellent buffet dinner prepared by different members of the group. After dinner, Fr. Rob Travis of Ascension parish gave a 45 minute on some aspect of Christian living, based on the topics outlined by the Alpha course but illustrated by experiences from his own life. This was followed by a brief break for coffee and dessert and then the participants met in one of two groups to share what they received from the talk and how the topic accorded with the stories of their lives. The whole effort was wonderfully coordinated by Linda Curry; Joe Matthews and Linda Curry were group leaders, assisted by Peter Pezzelli of our parish and Tasha Connors of Ascension.

Father Rob and I had an opportunity to speak to each other each week while the small groups were meeting and we both agreed that we'd like to do Alpha again but each for our own parish. In the near future I'll meet with the leadership team from St. Francis to plan how best to proceed and how to reach out especially to those who might be questioning their faith. Alpha can be a great new beginning for so many.
