## **JUNE 23, 2019**

## From the Pastor,

"He is sifting out the hearts of men before his judgment seat." These words from the Battle Hymn of the Republic by Julia Ward Howe are applicable in every age, and certainly today, when the animosity against the Faith is becoming more and more aggressive.

There are two basic approaches to the issue. The first is the way of faith. I do not remain a Catholic simply because of where my family came from in Europe. Nor do I remain because I happen to agree with Church teaching or policy. I remain because I am convinced of the historical continuity between the present day Roman Catholic Church and the original Christian community. There is an unbroken line, which is known as Apostolic Succession, and which guarantees that the pope and bishops of today govern the Church with the authority that Christ gave to his apostles. Our Lord promised that "the gates of hell will not prevail against" the Church founded on the rock of Peter. He also promised the Holy Spirit, who preserves the Church from error and leads her in the development of understanding of the message of the Gospel.

The other approach is to decide what I think would suit me and look around for a community that teaches what I agree with. There are many groups who espouse this approach and present a platform or program that appeals to whatever attitudes are most in vogue. Of course, vogues change from age to age and these groups must scramble about to trim their teachings to fit the world they happen to live in at the present.

G. K. Chesterton, a great wit and a convert to Catholicism a hundred years ago, wrote, "I don't need a Church that tells me I'm wrong when I know I'm wrong; I need one that tells me I'm wrong when I think I'm right." One, holy, catholic, and apostolic.

The teens of the Parish will be having a fundraiser next weekend, June 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> at St. Francis and the week-


