DECEMBER 8, 2019

From the Pastor,

A couple of weeks ago I passed on to you the thoughts of Pope Francis about the importance of prayer as a preparation for Mass and his objection to chatting in the church while waiting for Mass to begin. I prefaced the quotation by asking what your thoughts might be on this subject. Several people asked me what the reaction had been but no one offered any thoughts of his or her own.

I will admit that I would like to dissent in a very small way from the words of the Holy Father. One of the reasons to go to churchalthough not among the most important-is to see our fellow parishioners whom we hadn't seen all week. I don't think that a very brief chat with the people you sit next to every weekend does a great deal of harm as long as we go on to spend some time in prayer in preparation for Mass. One thing to remember, however: as we get older, our sense of hearing diminishes and sometimes we think we're whispering when we can actually be heard six pews away. It's good to remember that other people may be trying to pray and that our chit chat may be quite distracting. You may notice that new churches are built with large vestibules, "gathering spaces," where people can interact in an informal way before entering the nave of the church to pray. Both our churches were built in a different age and have very little gathering space, so we have to make do. In any case, it's good to remember that our Lord is present in the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle and we should not lose this opportunity to enjoy his presence and communicate with him.

Elsewhere in the news: please spread the word about Alpha, which is coming up in January. It's a reintroduction to basic Christianity and effort to move us towards a personal relationship with Christ.

Also, remember the "Giving Tree." Drop your gift cards into the collection basket on the weekends, or bring them by the rectory. Outside of business hours, please leave them in the mailbox outside the office door. Thanks so much for your generosity!
