

From the Pastor,

Margaret Dolan was a faithful summer member of the worship community at St. Romuald's for many years. She died at the age of 101 and was buried from the chapel last month. Her family very kindly requested that gifts in her memory be made to the chapel and to date \$2,275 has been given in her honor. God rest her soul. The family members have agreed that we can use those funds toward paving the area along Atlantic Ave. between the roadway and the stone wall outside the chapel, which will remove the problem of mud during the winter or the summer rains. Many thanks to Margaret's daughter Regina Brannon and her siblings for their kind gesture of generosity toward St. Romuald's.

Also, thanks to Kristen Di Santo for her generous donation in memory of her uncle Steve Parente that has been used to purchase kneelers to be used for weddings at St. Romuald's.

A couple of weeks ago, I mentioned the bulletins from the members of the parish Catholic Action group in 1948. In those days Mass could be celebrated only in the morning; there was no such thing as an afternoon or evening Mass. There was also music only at the one "High Mass" on Sunday morning, usually the last Mass of the day and only outside of summertime. According to the Catholic Action newsletter, the schedule at St. Francis each Sunday was 6:45, 8 & 10 a.m. There was no Mass at the chapel except in the summer, when the schedule there was 8, 9 & 10. During the school year, there was a Mass "at the college" (I take it that meant URI, since Christ the King was not yet founded) at 8:30 a.m.

Several things: good luck nowadays at getting college students to Mass at 8:30 a.m.! Also, I notice that there were 3 priests full-time in the parish in those days: the Pastor Fr. James Greenan and Fathers Thomas Hart and William Gillooly. There was also a fourth priest assigned full-time just for the summer. In 1948 it was Father Robert Mooney.
