From the Pastor,

Lent has well and truly begun. The poignant words of the Prophet Ezekiel ring in our ears: "Why should you die, house of Israel? For I find no pleasure in the death of anyone who die. So turn back and live!"

We have now until Easter to try to reorient ourselves toward Christ and the values of the gospel. The three-fold plan we have inherited from the Jewish tradition is prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Some may remember when every day of Lent was a day of fasting and at least partial abstention from meat products. Now there are only two days of fasting and eight of abstinence from meat. So since there is almost no communal penance any more, it's up to each one of us to devise a program that includes some combination of the three elements mentioned above.

As to fasting beyond the days already mentioned, it's up to you what you will "give up for Lent."

One of the ways to add prayer to one's day is by attending weekday Mass. There are Masses in our area at 7 a.m. here at St. Francis's (except on Wednesdays); at 8 at St. Veronica's at Bonnet Shores, at St. Mary's Star of the Sea in Point Judith and at Christ the King in Kingston; at 8:30 at St. James's chapel in Charlestown; and at the URI Catholic Center at noon on Fridays and at 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday. (Morning Mass here at St. Francis usually takes less than 22 minutes.) There is also Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament here at St. Francis every Monday from 7:30 a.m. till noon and Stations of the Cross every Wednesday at 12:30 at St. Romuald's and at St. Francis every Friday at 7 p.m. There are also pamphlets called "The Word Among Us," meditations for each day of Lent, which can be found at doors of the church and chapel.

As to almsgiving: please remember the St. Vincent de Paul boxes in the north and east vestibules of the parish church and by the front door of the chapel. All funds collected will go directly to people in our area who are in dire financial need. The Rice Bowls will also be collected on Palm Sunday and the proceeds will go to Catholic Overseas Relief Services.


