


SANCTUARY LAMP

The Holy Spirit and Prayer

"The Holy Spirit, the artisan of God's works, is the master of prayer" (Catechism

of the Catholic Church [CCC], #741). Prayer includes everything that we do to communicate with God in order to maintain and enhance our relationship. The Holy Spirit, who always empowers us for greater life and bonds us with others through love, is thus constantly at work whenever we pray.

The Holy Spirit bonds us with God the Trinity. "In the Holy Spirit, Christian prayer is a communion of love with the Father, not only through Christ but also in him" (CCC, #2615). Through the Holy Spirit, we grow in our knowledge of God and learn to express our love for God and for others in appropriate words, gestures and actions.

"The Holy Spirit, whose anointing permeates our whole being, is the interior Master of Christian prayer. To be sure, there are as many paths of prayer as there are persons who pray, but it is the same Spirit acting in all and with all. It is in the communion of the Holy Spirit that Christian prayer is prayer in the Church" (CCC, #2672). We trust that the Holy Spirit will guide us on our personal path to holiness and a fuller life with God.




