From the Pastor,

Persevering in Prayer
Taken from Magnificat-March 2020

Prayer by itself has value as an objective act....Considering prayer as a simple, potent activity that a person must fulfill in order for his life to be complete, eliminates a whole series of false questions about sincerity or insincerity. Going to Mass when we feel nothing for God is not at all a form of hypocrisy—it is faith....To make the emotions the gauge of religion would end in many aberrations. This is true of all personal relationships: love is situated beyond our emotions, which does not, however, mean that we distrust them. Emotion means the wonderful experience of love through a certain harmony of being. Love, on the other hand, is the very fact of a communion established between two beings situated on a level that is more profound than the sphere of our feelings.

Sincerity does not consist in conforming our behavior to our spiritual states, but rather in maintaining our behavior in spite of our spiritual states, in maintaining our profound fidelities in spite of our superficial infidelities. To be sincere means to be faithful to that to which we have truly given our heart in the fullness of freedom. This is what ought to exist in marriage and in friendship, in spite of all the possible external vicissitudes. Loving God means knowing that we can count on God and that God can count on us in spite of our emotional complications. Referring to the theological virtues, Jacques Rivière once said that "faith means to believe in God in spite of appearances; charity, to love our brothers in spite of what they may do to us; hope, to hope for spiritual goods even when they seem to be impossible." We must therefore protect the substance of prayer from the vicissitudes of our experience and from our religious feelings, because it is founded on something that lies beyond them: prayer is the expression of our fundamental relations to God.
