

# From the Pastor,

On **July 6** we are going to add two Masses to the Sunday schedule. Masses at the chapel will be at 8 and 10 and at the church at 9 and 11. The 9 a.m. Mass will continue to be live-streamed for the foreseeable future. We are still required by law to stop admittance to the buildings once the limit of people is reached as demanded by the 6-foot separation. So if you come late, you probably won't be able get in and that will be entirely on you. Not even the 3-month deprivation of Holy Communion can get some people to treat the Mass with respect and arrive on time to hear the sacred scripture readings. So please see the next paragraph.

It's fortunate for us that Fr. Albert Duggan, O.P., the chaplain of the Brown U. and RISD Catholic Community, will be available to help with the Mass schedule for the summer. I fear that the days are fast approaching when we shall not have the priests to supply all these Masses, and the Catholic people who are real believers and love and respect the Mass will have to schedule their Sundays around whatever Mass is available in their area. I am grateful that we are not yet at that point and I thank Fr. Duggan and the still-able retired priests, who are helping to postpone the eventual day.

The parish office will reopen on Monday, July 6, and will be open Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. For the rest of the summer, the office will **be closed on Fridays.** Please consider doing over the phone whatever business you can. If there is something that cannot be done that way and you need to come by the office, please plan to wear a mask. Budget envelopes and other such things can be left in the mailbox to the left of the office door.
