



AUGUST 16, 2020

As we celebrated yesterday the Solemnity of Our Lady's Assumption into heaven, so on the octave of that great feast, August 22, we shall celebrate the Queenship of Mary. Here is a reflection from Venerable Francis Xavier Nguyen Van Thuan, the Archbishop of Saigon, who was held prisoner by the Vietnamese Communist government for thirteen years. A year before his death in 2002, Pope John Paul II made him a Cardinal of the Roman Church.

"O Woman, great is your faith"

Very often, as is seen throughout Scripture and history, it is because of women that men are able to listen to God and to live the mystery of grace with its demands.

Mary, Mother of God,

you are the model of faith for all of us—men and women.

You are the representative of all humanity, because you welcomed the most sublime

of all graces:

the presence of God on earth.

God's presence transforms all things,

even if no exterior change is apparent.

The most marvelous mystery in the history of humanity

was accomplished through your offering and collaboration:

God became man.

For having believed, you are blessed and worthy of praise.

Your existence is the fountain of joy and blessing for all women and men who believe as you believed.


