


# From the Pastor,

Many thanks to all who have been able to renew their usual Catholic Charities pledge or donation this year. As you can imagine, the Charity Fund is not doing as well as it usually does: people have been out of work; others depended on the in-pew solicitation to make their donation. So I have great news! The diocese has designated next Sunday, September 13, for an in-pew solicitation. Woohoo! Now, because of pandemic precautions we are not going to leave the forms in the pews but will have them at the entrance of the church and of the chapel for those who have not yet given. Please take them home with you and bring them back the following Sunday. God bless the work!

My sincere thanks to Fr. Albert Duggan, OP who has been such a help over the summer months. I don't know what we would have done without him. He is an alumnus of Brown University's class of 2003 and was ordained to the priesthood in May of 2013. For the last five years he has been the chaplain of the Brown-RISD Catholic Community and has managed to do what none of his predecessors could: raise the funds to purchase a building as a Catholic Center. His provincial superior has now decided that he is to be transferred to a position in the administration of the province. So in January he will be moving to New York City and we wish him Godspeed as he sets out on this new adventure. His successor, Fr. Edmund McCullough, OP has already arrived in Providence and said the 11 a.m. Mass here last Sunday. We pray that despite the pandemic, his ministry will be bear much fruit for the good of the Church and the world.

This Sunday is the last for the summer schedule at the chapel. Next Sunday we'll return to the usual schedule of 9 and 11 at the parish church and 10 a.m. at the chapel. Please see last week's bulletin for my plan to resume the Saturday 4:30 Mass after Columbus Day if we can get enough volunteer pre-Mass greeters and post-Mass and sanitizers. ### 2020-2021 Religious Education Start Up

With the pandemic still with us we want to re-start the year

### **Catechetical Sunday**

The Religious Education year begins on Catechetical Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>.

On Catechetical Sunday we will have a **RE** Family Faith on the Go Event! Each family with children in Grades 1-6 will be assigned a time to come to the church parking lot (remain in their cars) and pick up Religious Ed. materials for their family. Masked and gloved volunteers will hand each family the materials needed for their child's distance learning for the next few months. Children in Grade 7 will receive their student workbook at their first in person class on October 7<sup>th</sup> while Grade 8 will receive their materials on October 14<sup>th</sup>.

### **Registration for Classes**



Those families **new** to the parish and families with children entering First Grade **must** register for classes. Families with children in Catholic school in Grade 2

and Grades 7 & 8 must register for First Holy Communion and Confirmation.
