NOVEMBER 1, 2020

From the Pastor,

This has been a season of the diaconate. Last month Dan Mahoney was ordained to the "transitional" diaconate, meaning that he will go on to the priesthood; this month Joe Clossick was ordained to the "permanent" diaconate and has been assigned to the parish of St. Thomas More in Narragansett. Deacons are no longer laymen but are part of the ordained clergy of the Church. All or nearly all of them are married men who have received several years of training in theology, preaching, and pastoral practice and at the same time are holding regular jobs. Most of them are ordained when their children are grown and the demands of parenting have lessened.

The first deacons of the Church were set aside by the Apostles to supervise the distribution of the contributions of the faithful and to make sure that orphans and widows were taken care of. The Acts of the Apostles records the thinking of The Twelve: "It is not right for us to neglect the word of God in order to wait on tables, "and seven men were chosen to organize this practical ministry. To this day, pastoral and administrative work is essential to the diaconate. Deacons also have a liturgical role, proclaiming the gospel, peaching from time to time, and assisting the celebrant at the altar. They can also administer baptisms, preside at weddings, conduct funeral rites apart from the Mass, and perform the rites of burial at cemeteries.

In our parish we have been blessed with the ministry of a number of deacons over the years and now have the blessing of Deacon John Dowd, who, in addition to the roles mentioned above, also ran our last Alpha Course and has kept the group together in the ensuing months. He also gives a very practical, down-to-earth and faith-filled homily for which all of us are most grateful.

God bless the deacons and all their labors on behalf of the People of God!
