



DECEMBER 6, 2020

Kallistos Ware, baptized Timothy in the Anglican tradition, is an English convert to Eastern Orthodoxy. He received the name of Kallistos when he was tonsured as a monk in the Greek Orthodox Church and he is now an Archbishop of that Church in the United Kingdom. Here is a brief reflection of his on "watchfulness," a word about which we hear much in the season of Advent.

Be WatchfulIs 11:1-10/Lk 10:21-24

Watchfulness means, among other things, to be present where we are—at this particular point in space, at this particular moment in time. All too often we are scattered and dispersed; we are living, not with alertness in the present, but with nostalgia in the past, or with misgiving and wishful thinking in the future. While we are indeed required responsibly to plan for the future—for watchfulness is the opposite of fecklessness—we are to think about the future only so far as it depends upon the present moment. Anxiety over remote possibilities which lie altogether beyond our immediate control is sheer waste of our spiritual energies. The watchful person is the one who understands this "sacrament of the present moment," and who tries to live by it.—Kallistos Ware *The Orthodox Way*


