

SAVE THE DATE: OUR ANNUAL PARISH MISSION BEGINS <u>Next</u> Weekend of March 6/7

The annual parish mission this year will be led by the newly-retired pastor of St. Bernard's in Wickford, Fr. John Unsworth, who served as a deacon in this parish in the summer of 1975 before returning to Louvain to complete his studies for the priesthood. His theme will be "Lent: A Parish Pilgrimage to Easter." Because we are restricted this year from making physical journeys to places of pilgrimage, can we reimagine Lent in terms of a spiritual pilgrimage, a grace-filled movement toward an encounter with the Holy?

Fr. Unsworth, will preach at all the Masses next weekend of March 6-7. He will preach at the live-streamed Mass at 7 p.m. on the Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of that week and will be available for confessions each evening from 6-6:45. Mark your calendars!

From the Pastor,

Please consider marking your calendars to attend the annual parish mission on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, March 8, 9, and 10. Father John Unsworth was the pastor of St. Bernard's in Wickford until last July when he retired after more than 40 years of parish work. At one time, he was the youngest pastor in the diocese when he was appointed by Bishop Gelineau to St. Mary's in Pawtucket, a large parish with a school and a cemetery. Some years later he was transferred to St. Brendan's in the Riverside section of East Providence, another parish with a school, and about 10 or 12 years ago was made pastor of St. Bernard's, which had just built a new parish church. Fr. Unsworth led the campaign to pay the debt on the new church, rehabilitate the farm house next door as the rectory, and some years later led the parish in building a new parish center. Now, in his "retirement," he has been appointed by Bishop Tobin as the liaison to the other senior priests of the diocese, and will be responsible for keeping in touch with the elderly clergy, especially those living on their own.

A few years ago, Fr. Unsworth went on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land and found it such so moving that he would like to lead us to a similar experience: in effect, we'll go on pilgrimage while having to stay at home. So the theme will be "Lent: A Parish Pilgrimage to Easter." Each evening Fr. Unsworth will hear confessions in the reconciliation room behind the pulpit from 6 to 6:45. Mass will be celebrated at 7 p.m. and after Mass, Father will speak and answer questions and take comments from the congregation. The evening will end by 8 p.m. For those unable to attend, the evening will be livestreamed to our parish website: stfranciswakefield.com. I hope you can join us.



Regarding Catholic School Assistance:

The Diocese of Providence urges all parishes to support Catholic Schools by giving aid, as far as possible, when parents request it. As believers in the value of Catholic Schools, we are happy to do that, both to the fullest extent allowable, and to the extent that the parish can afford. Some things to note, however! Eligibility for consideration requires that families:

- 1. Complete the Facts Form from the Catholic School Office. (No applications will be considered if the Facts Form has not been completed)
- 2. You must be registered parishioners of St. Francis of Assisi Parish & contributing members for at least a one year peri-
- 3. Attend Mass regularly.
- 4. Be actively involved in St. Francis of Assisi parish life.
- 5. All requests are to be turned into the parish office, whether your child has been accepted or not, no later than April 15.
