



From the Pastor,

Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! For the next 50 days we'll be celebrating the gift of resurrection unto eternal life, climaxing in the Solemnity of Pentecost, the greatest feast of the year with Christmas and Easter.

Next weekend has been designated recently as "Divine Mercy Sunday" and we will recite the Chaplet of Divine Mercy with the attendant prayers before the 10 a.m. Mass at the chapel. It will be livestreamed to our Facebook page and then transferred to the parish website and be available to all.

Someone once asked me what Divine Mercy Sunday was all about; was it claiming that God was in a good mood that day? No, it's not that God is in a good mood that day; it's that we focus that day in a special way what it always true: that God is "merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in kindness." You might go to Wikipedia on your computer and read about the claims of St. Faustina Kowalska about this devotion to Divine Mercy and her claims in that regard.

A word of explanation about indulgences. They are "a remission of temporal punishment due to sin," which means penance we might owe the Church in this life. They have nothing directly to do with "time in Purgatory." It might be helpful to remember that the word "purgatory" conveys the meaning of cleansing not of punishment. It's a matter of being scrubbed clean of our imperfections, not simply of paying off a legal debt.

In any case, a blessed Easter season to all!
