



Please call the rectory at least one year in advance to speak with Father Young. Due to the reduction in priests we can no longer accommodate Sunday weddings.



This week's sanctuary lamp at St. Francis Church burns in memory of John J. Marcoux.


COLLECTION FOR THE CHURCH IN LATIN AMERICA



In a moments time your world has just changed. You and your family must leave the country with what ever you can carry, not next week, but, now! Doesn't seem possible, however, nearly 70,000 Afghans had



to make that split second decision just 4 months ago. Now many are still living in military barracks as they await their fate here in the United States.

They have not been able to restart their lives because the Afghan Resettlement Agencies are understaffed and overwhelmed. St. Francis of Assisi church has been given the opportunity to help by becoming a "Sponsor Circle" and fostering an Afghan family.

Churches are being asked to create a support group, to provide initial financial support as well as mentoring for an incoming family. This will give our church the ability to come around a family, support them with gaining employment, housing, schooling, healthcare, basic needs and so on.
