

The Vatican II document "Gaudium et Spes" (Joy and Hope) was a pivotal document of the bishops at the Council. Remember that an Ecumenical Council like Vatican II is a gathering of all the bishops of the world guided and protected by the Holy Spirit. There have been 21 Ecumenical Councils since the beginning of the Church. (Fun fact: The Nicene Creed we say every week was mostly composed at the First Council of Nicaea in 325AD!)

Back to "Gaudium et Spes". It encouraged the Church to open up to the world. Two different interpretations of that were born. 1-We should become more LIKE the world. 2-We should go out INTO the world. This caused great tension in the Church in the last few decades. Should we "update" Jesus' teachings? Should our liturgies be more entertaining to attract people? I would say no.

I certainly am part of the second mode of thought. I believe the council called us to take the beauty, richness, and transcendence of Catholicism into the world that craves God. It is my dream that our parish can continue to bring the unchanging Gospel into an ever changing world. Isn't that exciting!?


NEWS FROM ST. VINCENT DEPAUL

In addition to the Friday dinner program that has served close to 10,000 meals in the past 15 months, our SVDP Conference continues to provide financial aid for rent, utilities, groceries and other needs. Rent assistance has remained our most frequent request. Recently a homeless



family of three was helped with first month's rent for Section 8 housing; electricity was restored after a shut off; and overdue rent paid for a family with an eviction notice. A family of three adults and a 5-year-old child with no heat or hot water during below freezing weather was provided with heating oil. Another family needed propane delivered for hot water and cooking after paying medical bills caused a financial hardship. A victim of domestic violence who was initially homeless was able to obtain affordable housing. Our conference assisted with securing and moving donated furniture. The needs are varied, and our Conference is not limited in the type of aid we can provide.


