



I wish to continue to discuss the wonderful heritage we have received through the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council in the 1960's. Pope John XXIII, in his opening speech on Oct. 11, 1962, declared that although the church had sometimes condemned errors with the greatest severity, it would best meet the needs of our time "by demonstrating the validity of her teaching rather than by condemnations." Sometimes we interpret this to mean that the Church gave up some of her more strict teachings.

Rather, the Church in our time prefers to pass on the beauty and profundity of her teaching in a positive way. The Council encouraged Catholics to learn their faith by prayer, reading, discussing, and assimilating it. So rather than saying "Don't do this or that", it is much more fruitful to say, "Here's why we do this or that". If you have difficulty with a teaching of the Church, or just want to learn more about a specific aspect, take the time to learn! Get involved in the parish's many learning opportunities. I promise you you will be mesmerized by the beauty of why and how we follow Jesus Christ!



#### From the Choir Loft



The Fourth Sunday of Lent is typically known as "Laetare Sunday". The priest wears a Rose vestment instead of Violet because it is a week of celebration marking the halfway point of Lent and Easter being

right around the corner. This is a day where some Lenten practices are relaxed before going into Holy Week. What does this mean for music? This means that I am going to play a postlude at the end of Mass which I normally give up for Lent. I found an organ arrangement of the Ukrainian national anthem which I have chosen as a postlude this Sunday.

During Holy Week, you will hear a variety of some of the most beautiful sacred music ever written and the choir will be making a return. On Palm Sunday, you will hear "The Palms" by Gabriel Faure. On Holy Thursday, you will hear a beautiful setting of "Ubi Caritas" written by Maurice Durufle during the washing of the feet and Mozart's "Ave Verum Corpus" will also be heard along with Marcel Dupre's Opus 45 no. 3 from his "Eight Short Preludes on Gregorian Themes, Op. 45" as an introit to the hymn "Pange Lingua Gloriosi". On Good Friday, the choir will sing a beautiful setting on "Crux Fidelis". On Holy Saturday, you will hear "Surrexit Christus" by Giovanni Battista Pergolesi. On Easter Sunday, I will play Louis Vierne's "Carillon de Westminster" from Pieces de fantasie, troisieme suite, Op. 54, no. 6 right after the closing hymn.

If you are interested in learning more about sacred music and wish to participate in it, make sure you join our parish choir. Rehearsals are Thursday evenings at 6:30pm.
