



#### A MESSAGE FROM THE CHOIR LOFT

I've recently been developing my skills in organ improvisation. I recently had a helpful lesson a couple weeks ago with an organist in Groton, Connecticut where I learned basic tricks in improvisation and it turns out that four semesters of music



theory have prepared me well. I got my inspiration from listening to hours of Olivier Latry's improvisations. For those of you who don't know who he is, he's the organist at the Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris, France. I will play a short Improvisation during Mass this morning to "Victimae Paschali Laudes" which is the Easter Sequence chant dating back to 1570 after the Council of Trent. It will be a great way to kick off the Easter Season. I will play improvisations like these from time to time and I reprogrammed the organ so I can play these.

The St. Francis parish choir is officially back in business and will sing every Sunday at the 11am Mass starting on April 24<sup>th</sup> (Divine Mercy Sunday) with a break during the summer season. If you're interested in joining the choir, please come to our rehearsals. No experience necessary. Rehearsals are Thursday nights at 6:30pm in the choir loft.


