


2022 Catholic Charity Appeal Goal is \$104, 595.00. As of 6/2/22 the pledged amount is \$88,393.00 from 272 donors.

How to draw your child back to the Catholic Church

6.5 people leave the Catholic Church for every one that joins, and 50% of young people who were raised Catholic are no longer Catholic today. Millions of mothers and fathers are longing for their prodigal children to come home to the Church, crying: "Where did we go wrong?"



The passive wait-and-see approach is no longer an option.

We need to understand the real reasons why our young people drift away, and we need a game plan to bring them home. If you find yourself in this situation (and many of us do!) join us on Monday, June 20th at 7pm in Fr. Greenan Center.

MISSION APPEAL: WEEKEND OF JUNE 25/26

The weekend of June 25/26 Rev. Thomas R. Carroll, a Piarist priest will be joining us from Kentucky to speak at Masses.

The Piarist Fathers were founded by St. Joseph Calasanctius in Rome in 1617. In addition to the vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, the Piarists take a fourth vow to educate youth. They operate between 195 and 200 schools in 32 countries around the world. One of those schools is located in the Appalachian region of eastern Kentucky.

They are asking for your support in helping them not only in their educational work in Appalachia but also in their many outreach programs designed to help those living in poverty in the mountains.

The three Piarists stationed in eastern Kentucky minister to the Catholics in four counties. Catholics number less than ½ of 1 % of the population. They thank you in advance for your anticipated generosity.
