



In honor of this amazing feast of Corpus Christi (The Body and Blood of Christ), I'd like to share with you some amazing facts about the power of the Eucharist:

1) *Union with Christ*: Reception of Jesus in the Eucharist fuses our being with that of Christ. St. Cyril of Alexandria describes it as similar to "when melted wax is fused with other wax."

2) Destruction of venial sin: The Eucharist destroys venial sin. Destroys! Through sin, the fervor of our charity can be dampened by venial sin. But when we receive the Eucharist we are united with Charity himself, which burns away the vestiges of our venial sins and leaves us cleansed and ready to begin again.

**3**) *Gives life*: According to the Catechism, the Eucharist "preserves, increases, and renews the life of grace received at Baptism" (CCC 1392). In other words, reception of the Eucharist increases the life of grace already present within us. Sounds even better than a trip to a spa!

4) *Peacemaking*: In the Synod on the Eucharist in 2005, the bishops discussed how the reception of the Eucharist in war-torn areas transformed the people of God and gave them the impetus to seek peace

5) *Commits us to the poor*: The words of St. John Chrysostom shame those of us who leave the Eucharistic table without caring for Christ in the poor: "You have tasted the Blood of the Lord, yet you do not recognize your brother...You dishonor this table when you do not judge worthy of sharing your food someone judged worthy to take part in this meal. God freed you from all your sins and invited you here, but you have not become more merciful."

What miracles does the Lord have planned for you this Sunday as you receive Him; Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity into your hearts?

ent, uncle, aunt, brother or sister?



#### MISSION APPEAL: NEXT WEEKEND, JUNE 25/26

Next weekend, 25/26 Rev. Thomas R. Carroll, a Piarist priest will be joining us from Kentucky to speak at Masses.

The Piarist Fathers were founded by St. Joseph Calasanctius in Rome in 1617. In addition to the vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, the Piarists take a fourth vow to educate youth. They operate between 195 and 200 schools in 32 countries around the world. One of those schools is located in the Appalachian region of eastern Kentucky.

They are asking for your support in helping them not only in their educational work in Appalachia but also in their many outreach programs designed to help those living in poverty in the mountains.

The three Piarists stationed in eastern Kentucky minister to the Catholics in four counties. Catholics number less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 1 % of the population. They thank you in advance for your anticipated generosity.
