



FROM THE DESK OF DEACON DOWD: CHANGE IS NEVER EASY

It was almost 20 years ago now that my wife Cathy and I were searching for a new parish. It is never easy when making such difficult decisions. It didn't happen overnight and took months of praying, discerning, visiting a variety of different parishes before we made a change. We truly were looking for a place that we felt God was calling us. There were lots of different places that we considered but when we visited St. Francis it was the only one that felt like home. I can still remember Cathy speaking about the welcoming community here and the many young families that worshipped on Sunday mornings. So after six months of commuting all the way from "North of the Tower" we made the move. It was one of the best decisions we have ever made. From the very start we were welcomed with open arms making friends and able to become involved in a variety of ministries which we so appreciated.

It was during this time that I once again felt the calling to the Deaconate. Your prayers, love and support during those years of formation helped me to stay focused and determined to complete the years of preparation and I was ordained on February 3rd 2013. This also meant another change as I was assigned to Our Lady of Mercy in East Greenwich for six and a half wonderful years. In May 2019, we moved to a new home in South Kingstown. Because of this move, Bishop Tobin was kind enough to give us time to settle and once again pray and discern as he said, "to find a place we felt I could best serve". At the urging of Father Bodah we were once again a part of the St. Francis community. For almost three years now, I have had the pleasure and honor to serve as your Deacon; this again was one of the best decisions we have made.

Change, as mentioned, is never easy but often for the best, if God is behind it. In the last number of months another need has emerged in our neighboring parish of St. Mary's and St. James. I was asked to consider making another change. Father Desmarais is in dire need of assistance after his deacon, and my good friend, Deacon Ray Castaldi passed away this past year. Cathy and I felt God's calling to try and help and so my new assignment begins August 1st. We will sorely miss being here but know that you are in great hands and well taken care of by Father Young a very energetic, enthusiastic and optimistic leader. I know he will continue to guide and strengthen you utilizing all of his wonderful gifts. I thank him for his support, prayers and understanding of this decision. Remember we are not that far away and who knows what changes the Lord may bring in the years to come.

This week's sanctuary lamp at St. Francis Church burns in memory of Ralph Calitri.




St. Vincent DePaul Society

Just a reminder that our St. Vincent de Paul chapter here at St. Francis needs your help. They ask your help by using their poor boxes located in the church and




