


SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Yes, summer is still with us but, it is mid-August and the start of our Faith Formation Classes is a month away. Here's what you need to know:

• Children enrolled in the program last year are automatically promoted to the next grade.

• Those families new to the parish and families with children entering First Grade must register their child/ren.

• If your child attends Catholic school and is in 2nd, 7th or 8th grade, you must register your child for First Holy Communion classes and Confirmation classes. (Confirmation classes begin in 7th grade with the sacrament of Confirmation received in 8^{th} grade.)

• Our Faith Formation information packet will be mailed the third week of August.
