



St. Jerome, a great Biblical scholar of the late-fourth/early-fifth century, insisted that "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of God." There are different ways in which we can make Scripture part of our lives. We hear it proclaimed at every Mass and when other sacraments are conferred, we can read and pray with Scripture on our own, and even today's technology is making Scripture more available to us.

Have you listened to the "Bible in a Year" podcast? Father Mike Schmitz hosts this podcast which launched in 2021. As the title implies, Fr. Mike is reading the whole Bible in a year and offering daily insights and commentaries on the Scripture that is read that day. The books are being read and grouped using more or a time frame approach rather than reading straight from cover-to-cover. Each of the 365 episodes is only between 20-30 minutes long so it is not overwhelming. Although it initially launched and was posted in 2021, you can find the podcasts wherever you get your podcasts from and start any time.

Honestly, I didn't listen to the podcast last year. I decided to start on January 1, 2022 and have been pretty good about keeping up with it. It is my go-to podcast when I am in the car and it certainly has been fruitful for me. Fr. Mike has a great way of speaking and connecting with his audience as he not only reads the Bible but also offers insights into what he is reading.

Scripture is the living word of God and speaks to us each time we read it or hear it proclaimed. I invite you to take some time with Scripture regularly.

Yes, summer is still with us but, it is mid-August and the start of our Faith Formation Classes is a month away. Here's what you need to know:

- Children <u>enrolled</u> in the program last year are automatically promoted to the next grade.
- Those families new to the parish and families with children entering First Grade must register their child/ren.
- If your child attends Catholic school and is in 2nd, 7th or 8th grade, you must register your child for First Holy Communion classes and Confirmation classes. (Confirmation classes begin in 7^a grade with the sacrament of Confirmation received in 8^a grade.)

- Our Faith Formation information packet will be mailed the third week of August.
