





ber on the outside of the envelope so that when the repair is complete you can be notified. Please drop your envelope off at the rectory or place it in the black mailbox next to the rectory door.



ST. FRANCIS COAT DRIVE: October 29




The annual St Francis of Assisi Coat Drive will be taking place a month earlier than in past years due to an increase need in our
