

### Today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord

Merry Christmas! For most of us, this is a season of joy. A season of giving. A season of lights and color and sound. A season of blessings, of family, of rejoicing. A season of love. For some, it also includes a sad reminder of loved ones lost, or memories of better times.

This is the world into which Jesus came: One that is not perfect and is a mix of joy and sorrow, and where people experience wonderful moments and undergo great suffering. He came for all of this, and for all of us. Today is a feast in the Church – a solemnity. It reflects the immense gravity and importance of the Incarnation, including how it points to Jesus' entire life, death, and resurrection – the mysterious means by which he redeems us – and not just the unfettered joy of the birth of a Savior.

Many are concerned that the world has lost its focus when it comes to Christmas and that the idea that "Jesus is the reason for the season" has been moved to the sidelines or no longer has meaning. Many wonder if it has turned into a purely secular holiday where getting gifts signifies greed, and joy and hope have been replaced with stress and anxiety.

There is a certain amount of truth in these observations. It would be dishonest not to acknowledge the earthly materialism that creeps into the celebrations, and that at times tempts us. The greater truth, however, is that even if we don't acknowledge it, Jesus himself is always present. He is never "not there." It is in his name we celebrate, whether the world says so explicitly or not: Christmas! He's there in the spirit of the season, in the giving of gifts, in the lights, the decorations, and in the time spent with family.

The Letter to the Hebrews says, In times past, God spoke in partial and various ways to our ancestors through the prophets; in these last days, he has spoken to us through the Son. The truth is, while the divine person of the Son ascended from the earth, since the moment of the Incarnation the Lord has never left us. In his name, and through the power of the Holy Spirit, we encounter Christ in word and sacrament – and in each other – and not just during this season. He dwells among and within us, always and everywhere. And whether at this time of year we rejoice or have sorrow, or a mixture of both, he sustains all things by his mighty word. He is Lord, and he loves us.

Jesus is the greatest gift we have ever received. God gave his only Son to walk among us and teach us the way to salvation. He is the Word made flesh – the promise fulfilled.
