

CHALLENGES AT ST. ROMUALD CHAPEL

Before I arrived, the process had already begun to try to find a solution to cover the dirt sidewalk in front of the Chapel. The rains and melting snow leave behind mud which makes it difficult to park a car or walk into the chapel. This has been a long drawn-out process as this involves getting approval from the Town of South Kingstown. Currently, I am in communication with a civil engineer recommended by the Diocese of Providence to find the right direction to follow in order to get this project to completion. This is a work in progress and I will keep you informed as we go along.

As you may know, the Town of South Kingstown will no longer be maintaining Community Road that is in back of the Chapel as with all private roads in the Town. This means that snow plowing and filling in the pot holes is left up to those who are along the road (private owners). I know that some residents are exploring this from a legal perspective. I will keep you informed as the process unfolds.


