



"KITCHEN OF HOPE" UPDATE:

Time for another update on the fundraising efforts for the renovation of the commercial kitchen in Fr. Greenan Hall. We are authorized from the Diocese to raise \$410,000. Below are the updated numbers (rounded off):

Direct Donations:	\$192,000
Kick-Off Fundraiser Gala:	\$13,000
March Madness	\$4,000
Memorial Bricks - Fundraiser:	\$16,000
"Mulligans for Meals" Golf Tournament:	\$33,000
Wine Tasting Event at Deepwell Manor	\$ <u>79,000</u>
Total Collected:	\$337,000
Pledges:	\$25,000
Total Amount	\$362,000

We are waiting for the town to issue the permit for this project. The construction bidding process has already begun. Our parish family has responded with great generosity, many thanks!

Again, I want to thank the parishioners at St. Thomas More Church and Christ the King Church for their contributions to this project. I am amazed that our neighboring parishes want to participate in the "Kitchen of Hope" not just financially but also with volunteers. They truly value the mission of reaching out to our neighboring communities to extend a welcoming hand to them.
