



Around The Parish Updates

Dear Parishioners:

Our "Wine Tasting Gala Fundraiser" held at the Deepwell Manor was a huge success. I want to thank Roland Fiore and his staff for allowing us to use the Manor for the night. Many thanks to all who volunteered and supported this event. I also want to thank the parishioners from St. Thomas Moore Church who were instrumental in making this night a success.

I want to thank Fr. Jared Costanza, pastor of Christ the King Church, who informed me that their finance council approved \$25,000 to be used toward the renovation of the kitchen.

Also, I want to thank St. Thomas Moore Church as I was informed that their finance council approved \$25,000 for this project.

The "Bistro Brick Patio" is complete at Fr. Greenan Hall. Please visit the right side of the Hall to see the patio. Some of the memorial bricks have been placed within the patio. We are also in the process of completing the left side of the Hall with memorial bricks within the steps leading up to the large brick circle at the top. The hope is to have a lighted statue at the top.

The gymnasium is in the process of being completed. The basketball hoops are up along with the padding on walls and the shades on the windows above. There is more work to be done such as getting the hardwood floor redone and striped.

The sidewalk at St. Romuald Chapel should start any time soon. If there is interest, memorial bricks can be installed at a later date

Since the town is no longer maintaining Community Road in back of the Chapel, we are looking at what can be done along with our neighbors in finding a path forward.

The wooden deck/steps on both entry ways on the right side of the Chapel need to be replaced. Hopefully we can get this started within a couple of weeks.

As soon as we get the numbers together, I will give an update on the amount of funds we have raised to date for the renovation of the commercial kitchen at Fr. Greenan Hall.

This week's sanctuary lamp at St. Francis Church burns in memory of Edward & Bill Carney.




