

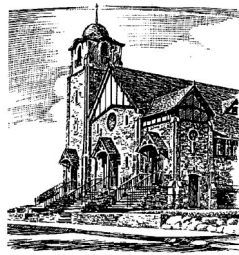
2026-2027 Faith Formation SUNDAY Classes Grades K-6
